CONDITIONS OF PURCHASE: Conditions of sale are set forth in the applicable 29th Annual Sun Valley Center for the Arts Wine Auction catalog as amended by any posted notices or oral announcements during the sale, such conditions of sale together with the following conditions applicable to telephone and absentee bids, constitute the entire terms on which property listed in the catalog shall be offered for sale or sold through Sun Valley Center for the Arts Wine Auction. See attached Conditions of Purchase.

1. The Sun Valley Center Wine Auction (herein the "seller") reserves the right to refuse admission to or attendance at all Sun Valley Center Wine Auction events.
2. The auctioneer is the agent for the seller.
3. The catalog, as amended by addendum or oral announcements during the sale, constitutes the entire statement of seller with respect to the sale and the purchase of wines listed herein.
4. Seller does not warrant or represent, expressly denies responsibility for, and in no event shall be responsible or liable for, the accuracy or description of wines offered, or the correctness of the catalog, including, but not limited to: the origin, rarity, age genuineness, or quantity. All statements by the seller are merely statements of opinion and are not to be relied upon by prospective purchasers as warranties or representations of fact. Prospective bidders, if so bidding, will be bidding only as a result of their own inspection and opinion. All wine is sold "AS IS."
5. All bids are per lot as set forth in the catalog, unless otherwise announced by the auctioneer.
6. A suggested minimum bid price has been established on all lots. Seller reserves the right to bid on his own behalf up to and including the minimum bid price.
7. No live auction bid shall be valid unless acknowledged by the auctioneer. At the fall of the hammer the highest acknowledged bidder shall be deemed to have purchased the lot and therein assumes full risk and responsibility. Purchaser warrants that he will then sign a confirmation of purchase and will pay the full purchase price herewith.
8. Should a dispute arise between bidders, or should the auctioneer doubt the validity of any bid, the auctioneer shall have the absolute right to resolve the dispute, re-offer, re-sell, or withdraw the lot in question.
9. Bids which are submitted to the seller in writing, or otherwise left with the seller prior to the sale for execution at or below a specified price, are entertained and executed by the seller for the convenience of the bidders, but the seller shall not be responsible for failing to execute such bids or for errors relating to the execution of such bids.
10. The silent auction bid closing will be announced. Silent bids must be increased by \$50 increments.
11. FULL PAYMENT MUST BE MADE BY SATURDAY, JULY 24, 2010 BETWEEN 10:00 AND 2:00 AT DOLLAR MOUNTAIN LODGE BY THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER OF ALL LOTS. The person who signs for a paddle number is solely responsible for payment if his or her number is the winning bid.
12. All payment from the successful bidder must be in cash, certified or personal check, or by VISA, MasterCard, American Express or Discover. The Sun Valley Center is required by law to charge Idaho sales tax of 9% on the suggested opening bid of all lots, including purchases leaving Idaho.
13. All shipping arrangements and costs are the responsibility of the purchaser.

ADDITIONAL ABSENTEE AND TELEPHONE BID CONDITIONS:

14. Sun Valley Center for the Arts Wine Auction is hereby authorized to bid on the designated lots up to the price entered and will treat this figure as a budget and will obtain the item as reasonably as possible within the budget.
15. We assume no responsibility for failure to execute bids for any reason whatsoever.
16. Sun Valley Center for the Arts Wine Auction encourages bidders to place absentee and telephone bids as soon as possible. Absentee and telephone bids will not be accepted after 5:00 pm, July 22, 2010.
17. In the event absentee bids of identical amounts are submitted, the earliest bid received takes precedence so please date this form. In the event of a tie bid, live bidders and telephone bidders, respectively, take precedence over absentee bids.
18. The Sun Valley Center for the Arts Wine Auction is not liable for any damage to goods after they have been sold.
